If interested, please complete the following steps:

- (1) Submit a proposal to nance.wilson@cortland.edu by September 15, 2023. Please save your paper proposal submission as: lastname.ARF2023GradStudentProposal.
- (2) Ask an ARF member to write a brief letter of nomination on your behalf. Letters of nomination should be sent to Dr. Nance Wilson at nance.wilson@cortland.edu by September 15, 2023.
- (3) Accepted proposals for a full paper will be informed by October 15, 2023.
- (4) Submit your conference presentation PowerPoint and all handouts by December 1, 2023.
- (5) You must register and attend the conference to be eligible for the scholarship.

Scholarship awards will be determined by the ARF Board and announced during the Business Meeting at the ARF conference in December.
